<u>Eyes Open</u>	
Spontaneous	4
To Speech	3
To Pain	2
Absent	1
<u>Verbal</u>	
Converses/Oriented	5
Converses/Disoriented	4
Inappropriate	3
Incomprehensible	2
Absent	1
<u>Motor</u>	
Obeys	6
Localizes Pain	5
Withdraws(flexion)	4
Decorticate(flexion) Rigidity	3
Decelerate(extension) Rigidity	2
Absent	1

The sum obtained in this scale is used to assess Coma and Impaired consciousness

- Mild 13 through 15 points
- Moderate 9 to 12 points
- Severe 3 through 8 points
- Patients with score less than 8 are in a *Coma*
